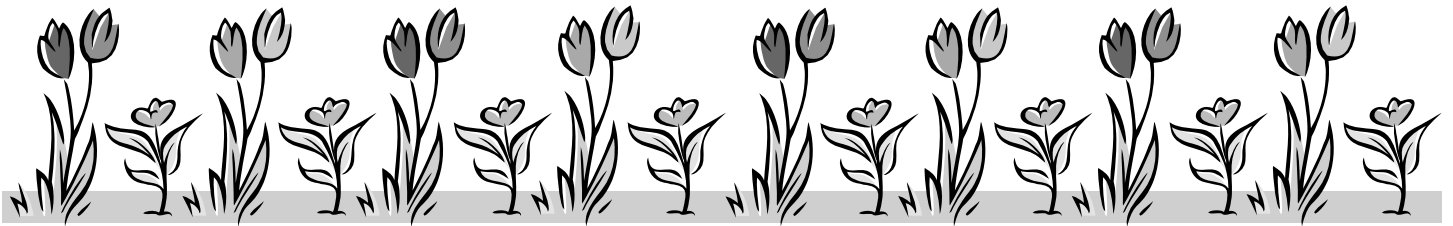

Chocolate Lovers Crustless Cheesecake (Dairy)

A drizzle of chocolate syrup and a dollop of whipped cream take this dessert into the realm of the extraordinary.

- 1 pound cream cheese -- softened
- 1 pound ricotta cheese, part skim milk
- 1 1/2 cups sugar
- 4 large eggs -- at room temperature
- 1/4 cup margarine
- 3 tablespoons all-purpose flour
- 3 tablespoons cornstarch
- 2 1/2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 2 cups sour cream

Preheat oven to 325. In a large electric mixing bowl combine the cream cheese, ricotta cheese, and sugar. Mix them together until smooth and then beat in the eggs, one at a time, and beating well after each addition. Add melted and cooled margarine, flour, cornstarch, and vanilla. Beat well. Fold in sour cream by hand. Pour the batter

into an ungreased 9" spring form pan. Bake, in center of oven for 1 hour. The cake will be soft in the center. Turn off the heat.

DO NOT, I repeat, DO NOT open the oven door. Leave the cheesecake sit for 2 hours. When the cake is completely cooled loosely cover it and then let it chill for 2 hours. Remove the cheesecake from pan to serving plate just before serving.
