MESSAGE FROM THE TREASURER

A few weeks ago Covid testing took place at Eldorado. It was a great success. We have been asked to repeat this testing and on Friday January 15, 2021 we will again be offering Covid testing. Please wear face masks and continue to practice social distancing including on the elevators.

As you know, the City of Aventura required Eldorado to move cars from the parking garage area in both upper and lower areas in both buildings. We are hoping to have the City, Engineer and contractor approval to allow Eldorado to gain back some of the parking in the next couple of weeks. We will again be moving cars once we start the parking garage. The City of Aventura wants the swale back as soon as possible.

The seawall is moving along well. The number of employees working on any given day depends on what tasks need to be done that day.

Eldorado had to reapply for permits and plans for the replacement of the seawall. The City of Aventura stepped into help facilitate our emergency situation with DERM and Army Core of Engineers to allow us to start the seawall. In addition, every step of the way requires our Engineer, DERM, Army Core of Engineers, and City approval before moving on to the next step

As mentioned in a previous weekly report, the seawall replacement and parking garage and drainage repairs comes at a large cost. Rest assured that we have the funds to complete the seawall and I believe we have the funds for the garage repair as well.

I think that Eldorado is doing well to be able to absorb these 2 expensive projects out of our Eldorado funds without using our Reserve.

We are not quite finished with the seawall and are in urgent need to start the repair of the parking garage and drainage system as soon as possible.

Choosing a company for the parking garage and drainage repairs has been a lengthy process. Our Engineer initially put this project out for bid to 20 companies with no response. The Engineer again resent this project out for bid a second time to 20 companies and eventually only received 2 bids.



We are unable to start the front until such time as the seawall and parking garage and drainage repairs are complete.

We continue to move forward with the front project. Plans for the front are currently with the City of Aventura. There are approximately 11 departments that have to study our various plans and make recommendations. The landscape architect will then have to make the necessary corrections as required by the City. We have no control over this process.

We do have the funds to complete the front project.

Please keep in mind that as the result of Covid, everything moves very slowly.

The Jacuzzi remains closed due to the difficulty in maintaining social distancing.
