Simply start up your coverage at the new company and then send a letter or fax to your original insurance agent stating when you would like your coverage discontinued. If there is remaining time on your policy, you will receive a refund of the amount you've already paid.

### Treats they Won't Give Away

It's back to school time! Below is a delicious and healthy treat to add to your child's packed lunch.

- 2 cups rolled oats
- 3/4 cup packed brown sugar
- 1/2 cup wheat germ
- 3/4 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 3/4 cup raisins (optional)
- 3/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 cup honey
- 1 egg, beaten
- 1/2 cup vegetable oil
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 1. Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Generously grease a 9x13 inch baking pan.
- 2. In a large bowl, mix together the oats, brown sugar, wheat germ, cinnamon,



- flour, raisins and salt. Make a well in the center, and pour in the honey, egg, oil and vanilla. Mix well using your hands. Pat the mixture evenly into the prepared pan.
- 3. Bake for 30 to 35 minutes in the preheated oven, until the bars begin to turn golden at the edges. Cool for 5 minutes, then cut into bars while still warm. Do not allow the bars to cool completely before cutting, or they will be too hard to cut.

### **Dog Days of Summer**

Most people have heard of the "dog days summer." But do you



really know what the phrase means? In general, it refers to the time between early July and early September when the weather is hot and muggy, leading to a period of stagnation or inactivity on the part of some people.

ancient times, people were very interested in studying the constellations. A pair of these, called Canis Major and Canis Minor, were considered to look like dogs in the sky. Because the brightest star in these constellations, called Sirius. was so bright, the ancient Romans thought that it gave off heat, like the sun. In late summer, Sirius rises and sets with the sun, leading the Romans to believe that the hot days were due to the extra heat Sirius was giving off during the day. Thus they began to call these days the "dog days." As the constellations have gradually drifted in their positions in the sky, the timing of the "dog days" has changed to earlier in the summer, from the beginning of July to the end of August.

- It is believed that mustard was first cultivated in India around 3000 BC. Recipes for mustard paste were recorded as early as 42 AD.
- The word "mustard" comes from the Latin "must" (much) and "ardens" (burning).
