Covenants Applications and Approvals

Biltmore II Condominium Association's governing Documents (Declarations, By-Laws & Rules and Regulations) require all owners to submit and receive approval by the Building Committee for major unit renovation before work can commence. The purpose of this process is to:

- Ensure compliance with Local, State and Federal laws and regulations;
- Ensure compliance with Biltmore II Condominium's governing Documents and to protect Association property values. Here are some common renovations which require an application and approval:
 - o Flooring replacement
 - o Replacement of HVAC (Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning) system and/or water heater
 - o Replacing windows
 - o Relocating electrical and/or plumbing
 - o Removing non-load bearing walls.

Remember, easy access to all of Biltmore II Condominium Association policies and rules are found on our website. Completed applications are considered by the Building Committee each month at their regularly scheduled meeting.

IMPORTANT TIP: Get your completed applications to the management office early so they may be reviewed. All pertinent information required **MUST** be submitted. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. We want to work with you and help you submit a flawless application! Give us sufficient time to work with you so that your chances of receiving an approval are good. Hard copies of the application forms are available in the Management office. A LIFE OF INTELLECTUAL AND SPIRITUAL ACHIEVEMENTS

One way or another, Olga and Ignacio del Valle have always been involved in intellectual pursuits either for their careers or for pure interest. Both of them have easily changed professions and fearlessly moved around the academic world acquiring degrees.

They came to Miami from Cuba in their teens and were educated in the United States. No matter what careers they chose, their goal was always to live in Miami and be near family and friends. They were able to achieve their dream, as their two children also settled here.

Olga's father was one of the first exiles to escape Castro's Cuba, and he brought his family to Coral Gables. Hence Olga was in 1959 the first Cuban girl to enroll in Coral Gables High. Their home soon became a gathering place for fellow exiles, and she remembers Ignacio from those days, as he enrolled in Coral Gables High in 1960.

But they went to different colleges. Olga had originally planned to study pre med but switched to organic chemistry

when she discovered an aptitude for the subject. "I love chemistry, and the professor who inspired me was excellent," she says. She graduated from the University of Miami (UM) with a Bachelor of Science in chemistry *cum laude*.

She and Ignacio married and moved to Pensacola where he was a chemical engineer for a Monsanto Chemical Plant. But soon after, Ignacio accepted an offer from Exxon Research Labs in Baton Rouge. This was familiar territory to him, as he had a Bachelor of Science in chemical engineering from Louisiana State University (LSU). By now they had two children, and he went to night school at LSU to get a master's degree in chemical engineering.

But Miami beckoned and in spite of much success at Exxon, Ignacio moved here to a consulting engineering firm that specialized in the sugar industry. At last Olga found work in a chemistry lab! Her first job was in quality control developing a program to identify all incoming raw materials to ensure the accuracy of their labels. Then she transferred to the challenging area of research.

Because of an economic downturn in the sugar industry circa 1970, Ignacio decided to pick another career and went to UM law school to get a Juris Doctor degree. He joined his father-in-law's law firm which specialized in the sugar industry but later branched out into real estate and banking.

Throughout his career Ignacio became a partner in various law firms specializing in real estate and banking. He

was head of the real estate departments representing investors, municipalities, public-private partnerships, etc. And he has been recognized for many years in the South Florida Legal Guide "Top Lawyers in South Florida."

Olga went back to study theology at Barry University and ended up with a master's degree in Pastoral Ministries. She also enrolled in graduate work at Florida International University to bring herself up to date with developments in chemistry. "My two loves," she says, "are chemistry and theology."

She acquired two more careers, one as a top realtor with Coldwell Banker and the other as a teacher of theology and chemistry. She taught seniors theology at her daughter's school,

Our Lady of Lourdes Academy, for 11 years. She taught at the Archdioceses of Miami. She was also recruited to teach chemistry and world religions at Miami-Dade Community College.

Both Ignacio and Olga experienced spiritual development in their lives and each had a mission to fulfill. Ignacio dedicated 18 years to the Kairos Prison Ministry, a Christian faith ministry that is ecumenical and addresses the spiritual needs of imprisoned men, women and youth and also includes their families. Community service was always a big factor.

Pinecrest was home to the del Valle family for 27 years. Their two children, Jorge and Betty, grew up there, and they were surrounded by cousins and friends. In 2001 they downsized to a smaller home in the Gables to be closer to their now married children and babysit the four grandkids. "I was always available

to do transportation," says Ignacio, "sometimes there were four different schools."

They downsized again in 2015 and moved to Biltmore II where Olga's mother had previously lived. At that point Ignacio retired. Olga quit all her jobs in 2006 to help with the grandchildren

Today their intellectual curiosity has not diminished. They both take courses at UM's Osher Lifelong Learning Institute (OLLI). They still chauffer the grandkids. They are blessed with a large family of cousins that takes turns hosting holiday family reunions. They volunteer their services in Biltmore II. Ignacio participates in the Violations Panel, and Olga organizes the concerts for the Social Club. And they enjoy all their social activities in the building which include the Domino and Canasta groups!
