NEW RULES & REGULATIONS

- Security must have the number and ability to call a unit owner in his/ her "unit".
- Unit owners must notify security and the office of visitors sleeping over.
- No admittance thru our center (Unit Owner) gate without a "current decal affixed to the lower comer of the passenger side front window by security or office.



• No Security Person will watch TV on the 7 am - 3 pm & the 3 pm - 11 pm shift.

New Association Rules (cont. from page 1)

- We watch our in-house cameras and cars disobeying our stop signs & speed limits will result in fines.
- Children under 16 years of age are NOT allowed in the Jacuzzi, gym or billiard room.
- Security must check that building roofs are locked.
 The Security person that opens the roof lock, must be sure to return to lock the roof.
- No unit owner is allowed on our roof at any time.
- Realtors must show their credentials to be allowed on the property & prospective buyers must be accompanied by the realtor.
- For outsiders using our auditorium, there must be a unit owner in attendance. (CLOSED NOW)
- Rover must check pool & Jacuzzi at least 3 times in an hour and take names of violators of our Rules & Regulations and to stop any violators by removing them from the Pool, Jacuzzi & Decks.
- Security when called must investigate and make a written report for dog barking, or any other disturbance: Investigate make report including Date, Time, Unit # & Who Reported.
- Security can NOT give anyone's phone number
- Unit owners must dry off (coming from pool or

Jacuzzi) before entering elevators Lobbies, etc.


- Unit owners using our exercise equipment must bring their own towel and clean after use.
- Unit owners leaving their units for vacation for an extended time should shut off their water line to prevent damage to our common area and/or their neighbor's property.
- Security must check dates on any and all parking passes.
- Saturday, NO deliveries except with prior notification and approval of the Board, which if approved, will only be "ONE" small package. Violators will be fined. This is your Warning. Sunday, nothing will be delivered except food.

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Spinach & Potato Frittata

Frittatas are excellent for Easter brunch and any Passover meal, because they're not reliant on grains in any way and can be totally flexible to accommodate leftovers. This recipe is Easterappropriate, Passover-approved, and an excellent ways to celebrate spring.

- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 6 small red potatoes, sliced
- 1 cup torn fresh spinach
- 2 tablespoons sliced green onions
- 1 teaspoon crushed garlic
- salt and pepper to taste
- 6 eggs
- 1/3 cup milk
- 1/2 cup shredded Cheddar cheese

Heat olive oil in a medium skillet over medium heat. Place potatoes in the skillet, cover, and cook about 10 minutes, until tender but firm. Mix in spinach, green onions, and garlic. Season with salt and pepper. Continue cooking 1 to 2 minutes, until spinach is wilted. In a medium bowl, beat together eggs and milk. Pour into the skillet over the vegetables. Sprinkle with Cheddar cheese. Reduce heat to low, cover, and cook 5 to 7 minutes, or until eggs are firm. Serves 6.
