

# Message from the Manager

#### VERY IMPORTANT

Please note\* there are signs posted at the front gates that state: "gate opens and closes after each car automatically." If you enter the lane where the scanners are located, and the gate arm is up from the car in front of you, you must wait for the arm to come down and then proceed. If you do not, the gate arm may come down on your car and cause damage that we are not responsible for. We have video in our office, which records each incident and we review all complaints. In 100% of the incidents, the driver did not wait for the gate to come down. Enter the gates slowly and do not tailgate the car in front of you.

## Parking

When a unit is sold in Coronado, in any of the three towers, the parking space does NOT go along with the unit. All parking spaces are assigned and reassigned by the Association. Parking spaces are NOT to be shared owner to owner without prior approval of Management.

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## **Detect-a-Leak Week**

for leaks that may be costing you money! Even a small leak can add up to hundreds of dollars a year, and could damage surrounding fixtures, cabinets, or floors.

One of the biggest culprits is the toilet. You often cannot tell if your toilet is leaking simply by examining it. Place a few drops of food coloring, just enough to slightly color the water, in the main tank. Let it sit for several hours, then check the toilet bowl. If you see the color in the bowl, you have a leaky toilet and it needs to be repaired. Check for dripping faucets, pipes, and connections by examining all plumbing in your home. Use a lightweight cloth to wipe around each connection. If your cloth becomes wet, you have leaky plumbing that needs to be repaired.

Don't forget to stop those leaks that you can control! Turn faucets off all the way. Don't let water run when you brush your teeth. And don't use your toilet as a wastebasket. Instead of throwing items such as tissues in the toilet and flushing, use a small wastebasket in your bathroom instead.
