HAPPY FATHER'S DAY

In the late 1800's, a baby girl, Sonora Smart, was born. Unfortunately, her mother died giving birth to her. The usual practice was to send such a child off to relatives who would care for her. But Sonora's father, William, chose to keep her close to home, raising the little girl along with her five siblings alone on a farm in eastern Washington.

Sonora grew up and married, becoming Sonora Smart Dodd. One day in 1909, she was sitting in church listening to a Mother's Day sermon. Thinking that her father deserved the same recognition as any mother did, she began an effort to designate a special day for fathers. The first Father's Day observance was held the following year in Spokane, Washington. She chose the month of June, the month of her father's birthday.



Within 15 years, this custom had spread across the country. In 1924, Calvin Coolidge issued the first presidential proclamation in support of Father's Day. President Richard Nixon made it a permanent designation in 1972. The third Sunday in June has become a National Day of Observance in honor of fathers everywhere. One woman's love for her father has inspired millions to honor their fathers as well.

Tis the Season Warm Weather Tune-Up Tips

Your bags are packed, your maps are unfolded, and the kids all have their snacks. You and your family are ready for your road trip, but is your car? As the weather gets warmer, there are some things you should do to ensure that every trip, short or long, is a safe one.

Do a check of all of your exterior lights and windshield wipers. Look over your tires to make sure that the tread is not worn down. Don't forget to check your spare also. This is a great time to get out your jack, make sure it is in working order, and review how to use it.

Under the hood, check the belts, battery, and all fluid levels. It is a good idea to get a fresh oil and filter change before and after a road trip. Fill up the washer fluid reservoirs and wash all the windows.

Inside your vehicle, do a safety check of all of your seat belts. Check any car seats that are in your car, making sure that they have been installed according to the manufacturer's instructions. Keep a safety kit in your vehicle. This should include first aid supplies, a wrench, screwdriver, flashlight, safety flares, extra water, and some rags.

SUMMERTIME REFRESHMENTS

Ah, summer! Never is there a better time for a refreshing, cool drink. With these recipes in hand, you'll be sure to look forward to the next hot day.

TEA PUNCH

1/2 cup sugar

1/2 cup black tea

2 cups orange juice

2 cups pineapple juice

2 cups lemonade

1 liter bottle of ginger ale

Dissolve the sugar into the tea in a pitcher. Add the orange juice, pineapple juice, and lemonade. Chill for at least four hours. Just before serving, add the ginger ale and serve immediately.

PINEAPPLE LEMONADE

1/2 cup sugar

1/2 cup lemon juice

2 cups water

4 cups pineapple juice

4 cups club soda

sliced lemon

Dissolve sugar into the lemon juice and water in a large pitcher. Add remaining ingredients & serve immediately, adding a slice of lemon to each glass.

WATERMELON COOLER

1 cup cubed watermelon 1 cup cubed honeydew melon 1 cup cubed cantaloupe 1 cup orange juice 1-1/2 cups mint tea

Fill a blender with ice. Add remaining ingredients and blend well. Pour into a tall glass. Garnish with melon balls and mint leaves.



LEMON SPRITZER

1 bottle (24 ounces) white grape juice 1 tablespoon grated lemon peel

1 sliced lemon

1/4 cup lemon juice

1/4 cup sugar

1/2 quart club soda

In a large saucepan, bring the grape juice to boiling. Add the lemon peel, juice, lemon slices and sugar. Stir until sugar is dissolved. Pour into a large pitcher and chill for at least 5 hours. Just before serving, add club soda. Pour into tall glasses filled with ice and garnish with mint leaves.
