# **RECYCLING DO'S & DON'TS**

Did you know that recycling items considered to be "contaminated" with these "Don't" items must be discarded as waste? Let's do our part to prevent this by observing some basic Recycling Guidelines.

### **ONLY INCLUDE:**

- Paper /Paperboard Products
- Cardboard
- Plastic Bottles
- Aluminum Cans
- Glass Bottles

# **DON'T INCLUDE:**

- ELECTRONIC WASTE AND ACCESSORIES ex. PCs, monitors, televisions, printer cartridges, keyboards, cell phones, home telephones, radios, speakers, CDs and DVDs, and CD and DVD players
- **MEDICAL WASTE AND PHARMACEUTICALS** ex. prescriptions, syringes, bio-hazard/medical containers. Miami Dade County has various locations to dispose of syringes and sharp medical waste. Please contact 311 for a location near you.
- GARBAGE OR OTHER NON-RECYCLABLE WASTE ex. household garbage (food), cylinders, propane and oxygen tanks, rocks, dirt, construction debris, flammables, yard and tree trimmings/clippings, bulky trash
- **PROHIBITED PLASTIC** ex. plastic bags, Styrofoam cups, plates and food containers, meat packing trays, Styrofoam egg cartons, plastic silverware
- HOME CHEMICALS ex. paints, pesticides, aerosol cans, engine/motor/ oil
- **CERTAIN GLASS PRODUCTS** ex. window or auto glass, incandescent and fluorescent light bulbs, mirrors, glass cookware or bakeware, ceramic
- **BATTERIES** ex. dry cell batteries, lead acid batteries Other Non-Recyclables ex. coat hangers, small appliances, microwave trays, cooking pots and pans

The city's annual budget process recently concluded. Our budget for 2023/24 totaled \$85 million. Your local Councilman Scott Galvin has secured \$30,000.00 for new native planting at the Arch Creek East Preserve.

# A Big Win for Arch Creek East, the City of North Miami, and the Environment



Thanks in large part to the efforts of Councilman Scott Galvin, Arch Creek East is celebrating North Miaimi's decision to approve a grant that will fund phase one of **Urban Paradise Guild's** sweeping proposal to fully restore the Arch Creek East Environmental Preserve and improve habitat conditions along ACE's five passive parks.

Urban Paradise Guild's multi-tiered proposal for Arch Creek East should serve the interests of both the environment and the community for years to come.

#### **AMONG ITS HIGHLIGHTS:**

- Building green defenses that mitigate dangerous storm surge and saltwater flooding east of Biscayne Boulevard, most notably the frequently flooded bayside area at the east end of 135th Street
- Habitat improvements to ACE's passive parks will provide a critical new connecting link for North Miami's "butterfly corridor"
- Restoring the preserve's native habitat will provide much-needed shade along public pathways
- Distinct travel lanes for bikers and walkers will make the preserve safer for visitors
- Expansion of the preserve's visitor base will increase the number of citizen-stakeholders committed to protecting the preserve from development
