OWNER'S UPDATE OCTAGON TOWERS CONDOMINIUM

- The work on the 19th St pedestrian exit door column should be completed very soon. We are still pending specific material that were already ordered.
- The generator project is still pending as we are now waiting for specifications of the Fire Pump that might be replaced, it will determine if the previously sized generator is still appropriate. The engineer is still working on this task.
- Suncoast Elevators is currently in the design/permitting process. They also already ordered parts for the modernization of both elevators.
- The landscape company should be back very soon to treat again the Ficus hedges against white fly.
- The lobby floor should be polished in the coming weeks. We are pending a date of completion from the contractor.
- Reminder: The trash chute is to be used only for trash previously bagged. No other item should be placed in the chute since it will clog it. Cardboard boxes need to be flattened and placed in the recycling container in the trash room.

GETTIN' FIGGY WITH IT

National Fig Week is November 1-7. It is a great time to enjoy the taste of figs. Many people are not familiar with this sweet fruit. The easiest way to use figs in recipes is to use dried figs, easily found at your local grocer year round. To help you enjoy them, we've compiled some delicious and easy recipes.

Poached Figs: Wash one pound of dried figs. Place the figs in a medium saucepan and cover with cold water. Add two tablespoons lemon juice and stew the figs, covered, until they are soft. Drain the juice from the figs and remove the figs from the pan.



Return the juice to the saucepan and simmer with about one cup of sugar until thick. Add back in the figs and stir. Let cool. Add one tablespoon dry sherry. Chill and serve with ice cream.

Thai Chicken Salad With Figs: To make the dressing, mix together 6 tablespoons fresh lime juice, 1/4 cup honey, 3 teaspoon light soy sauce, 1/4 teaspoon crushed red pepper flakes, and 2 teaspoons minced fresh gingerroot. Add 2 cups shredded cooked chicken and 1 cup dried figs, with stems removed and cut into eighths. Add 2 sliced green onions and 1/4 cup chopped fresh mint. Toss to coat evenly. Cover and refrigerate for one hour, stirring

occasionally. To serve, add to the mixture one chopped cucumber and 1/2 small cantaloupe, cut into small pieces. Line plates with salad greens and arrange mixture in center. Makes 6 servings.

Gorgonzola-Stuffed Figs: In a medium saucepan, combine 8 ounces dried figs with one cup sugar and one cup water. Heat to boiling and remove from heat. Cover figs and let stand until plumped and cool. Snip deep crosses into each and spread out until almost flat. Blend 12 ounces of soft cream cheese with 4 ounces of Gorgonzola or blue cheese. Fill center of figs with cheese mixture. Top each with one pecan half. Chill and serve cold.


