We are planning to send out regular communications to keep all owners and residents informed as work progresses.

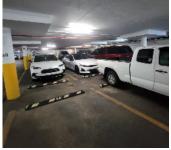

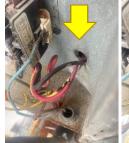

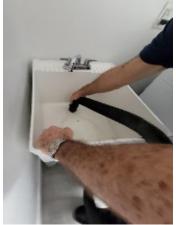

First Onsite provided water mitigation training for the staff on Tuesday, March 13, 2024. The training includes courses covering water damage restoration, and how to react in case of an emergency. This course is designed to teach nonrestoration personnel that perform remediation work to give them a better concept of water damage, its effects, and techniques for drying structures.

SAFETY TOPIC | TEMA DE SEGURIDAD

The FSR associates got together for the monthly safety meeting for the month of April, which was held in both English and Spanish. See flyers in English and Spanish attached.



Safety in the workplace begins with you. Our culture includes a focus on awareness and personal accountability to ensure work is completed in the safest way possible.

GSS #10 'Safety and security are everyone's responsibility. We follow safety policies and procedures, and we know our <u>individual and collective roles</u> in emergency situations.'

A culture of safety does not mean having an incident free workplace. It means having a workforce with

associates who are alert, aware of their surroundings and are always on the lookout for any potential hazards or dangerous conditions. Being alert means always being able to spot potential hazards.

We rely on electricity as a part of our day-to-day operations. Common examples include tools, housekeeping equipment, office equipment and lighting. Working with electricity, directly or indirectly, can create hazards and may even become deadly. Unfortunately, many people are unaware of the hazards and are more susceptible to injury.

According to OSHA, the most common electrical injuries in the workplace include:

- Contact with power lines or other electrically charged sources (i.e., tools and equipment)
- · Lack of ground fault protection (this is equipment that provides protection from the effect of ground faults)
- Path to ground missing or interrupted; this can be due to deterioration, mechanical damage or environmental wear and tear.
 - · Electrically charged equipment not being used in
 - Improper use of electrical / extension cords

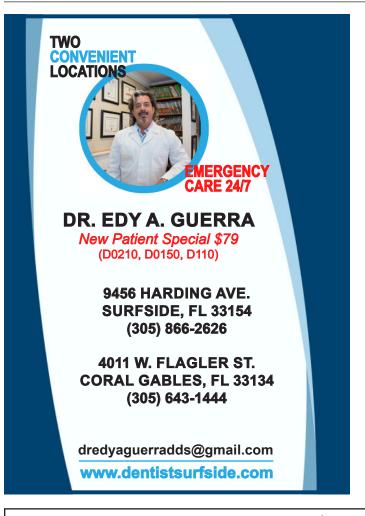
